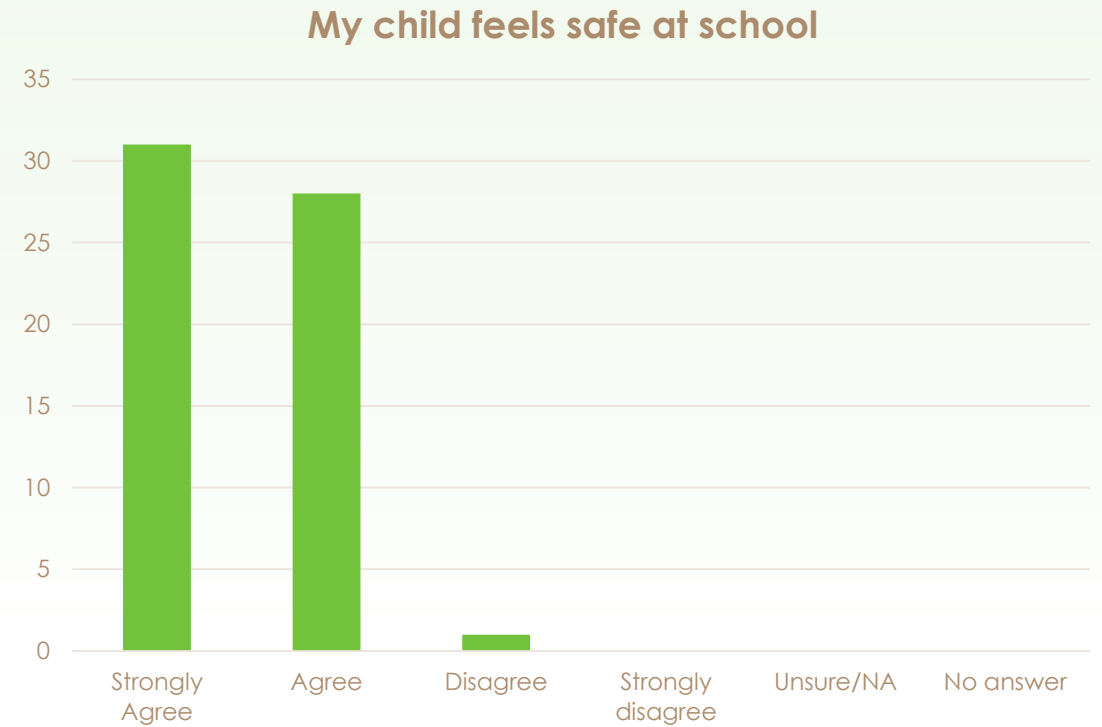

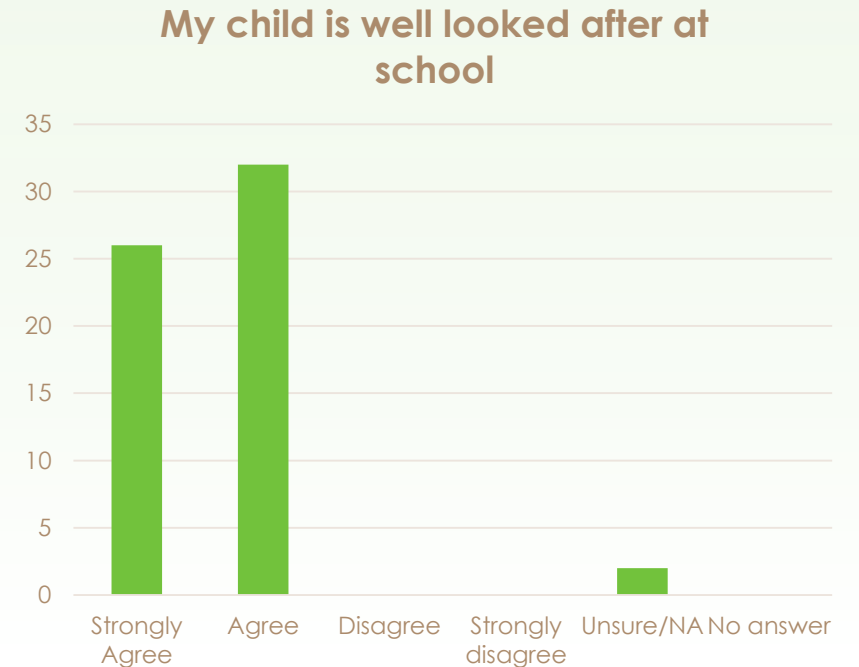

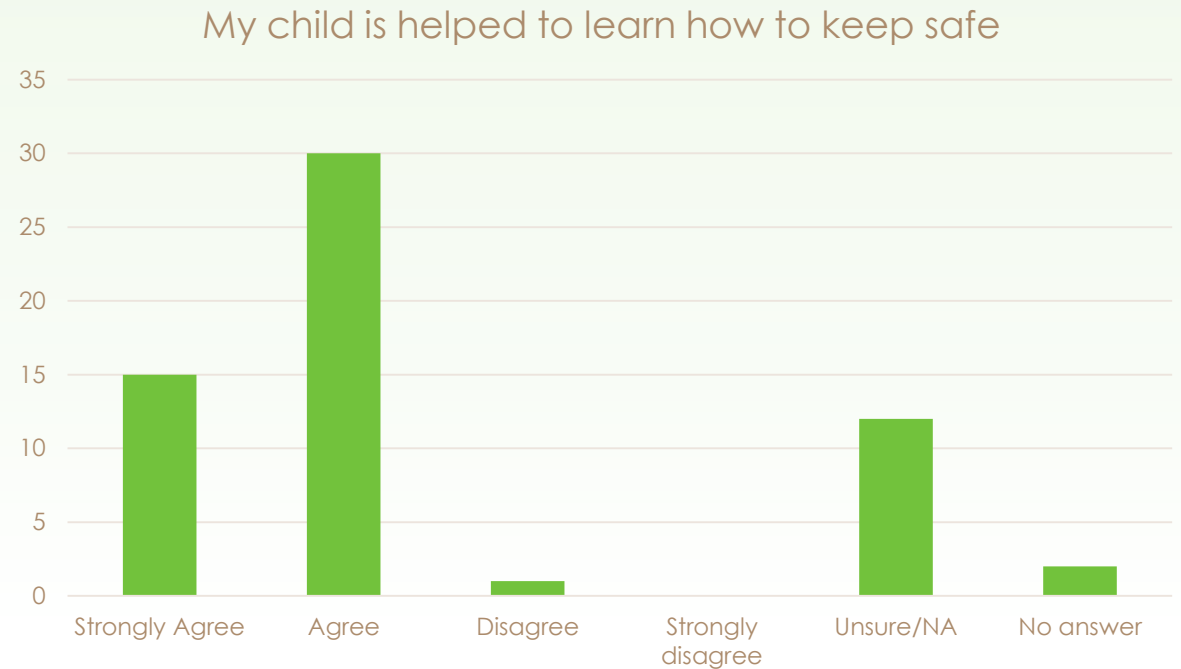

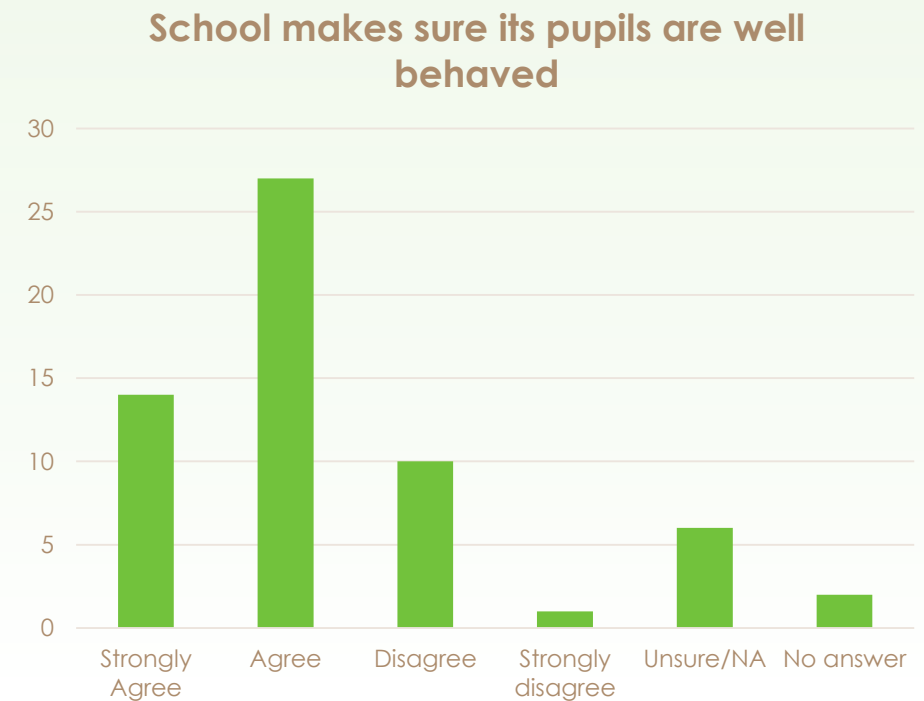

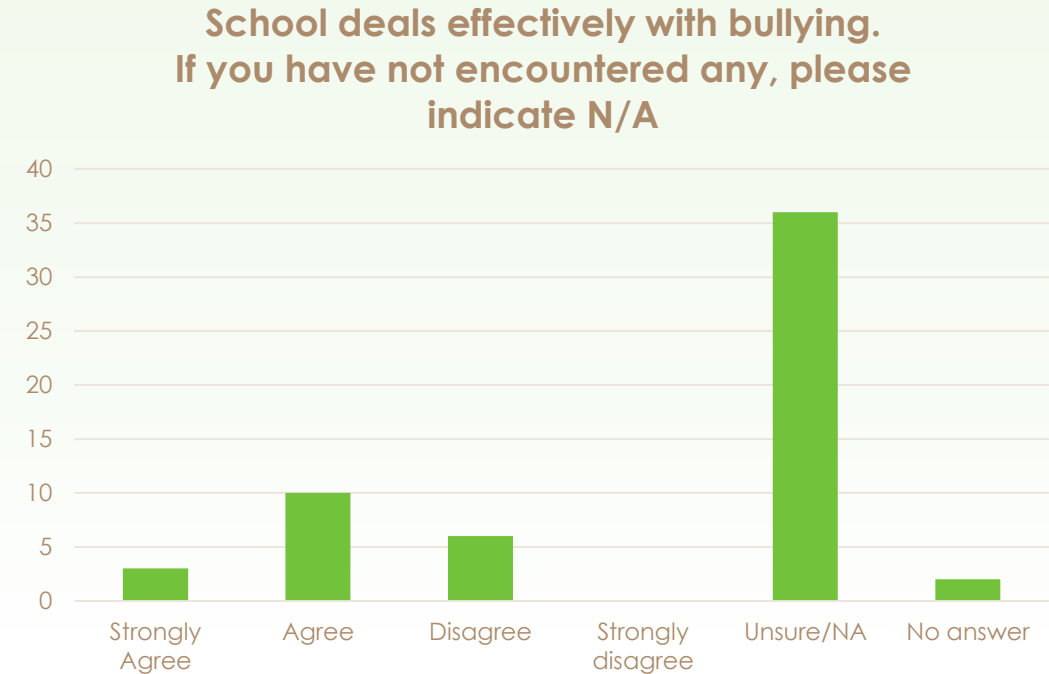

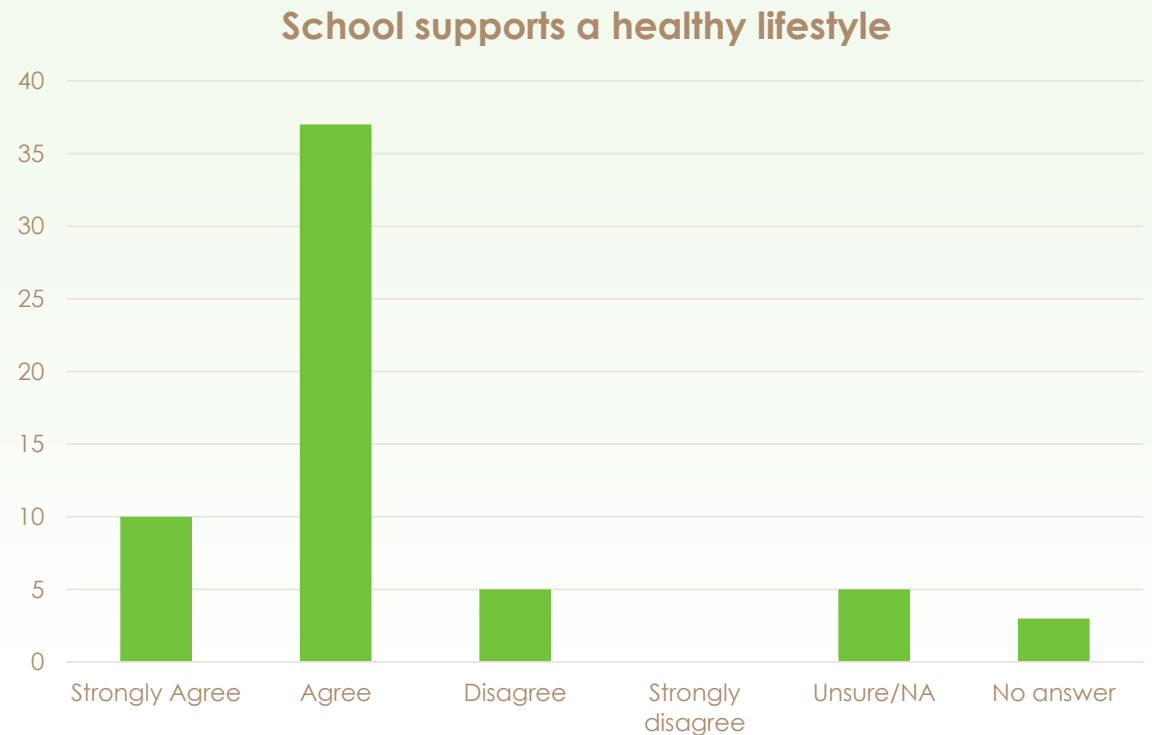

Sweets – given out at end of day, shouldn't allow them for birthdays

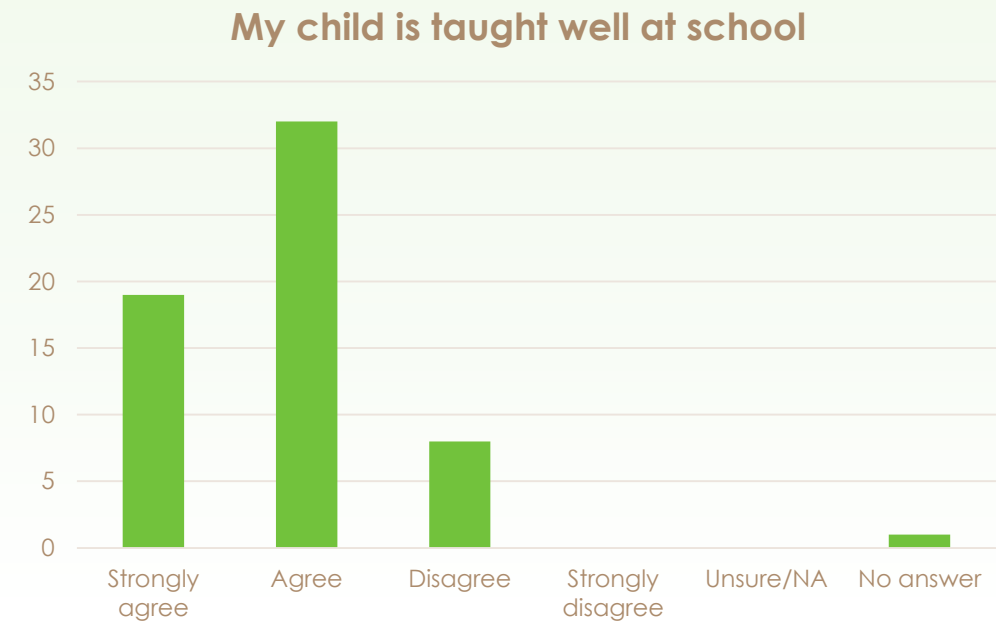

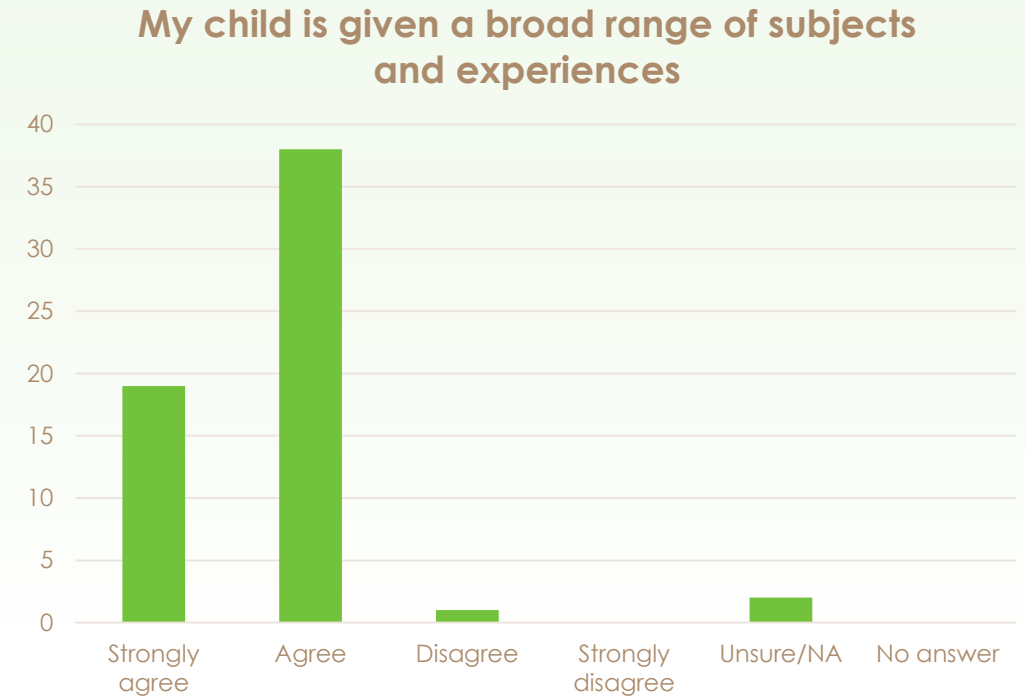

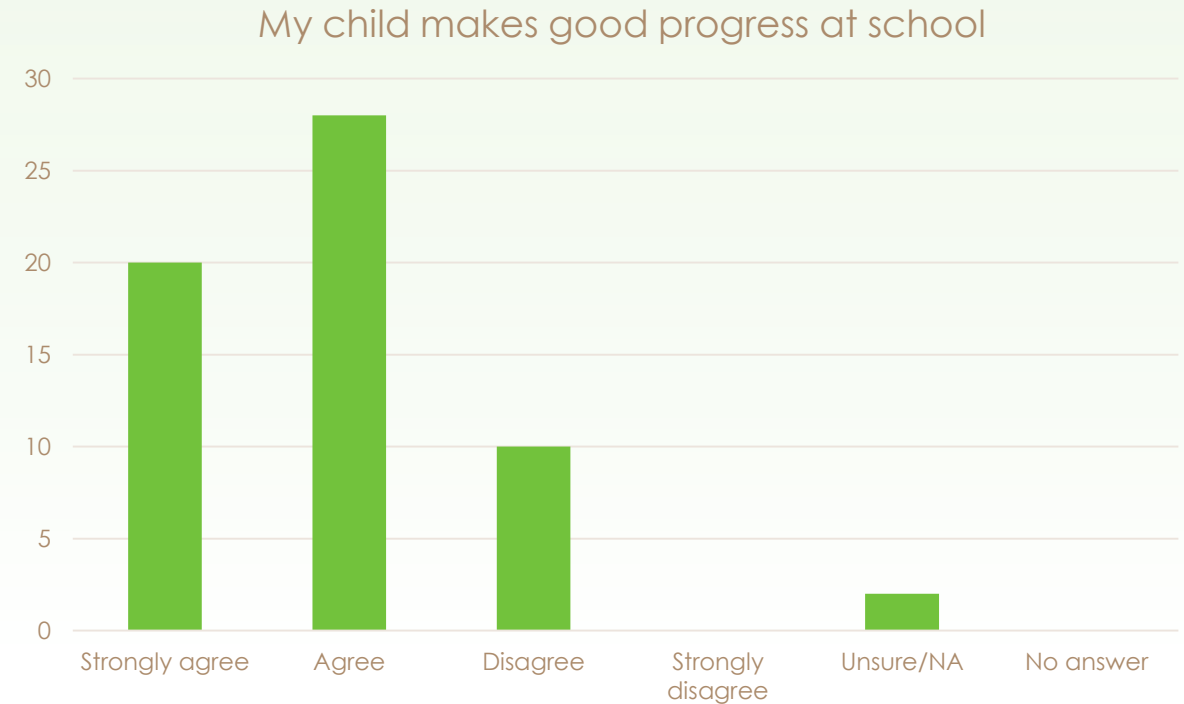

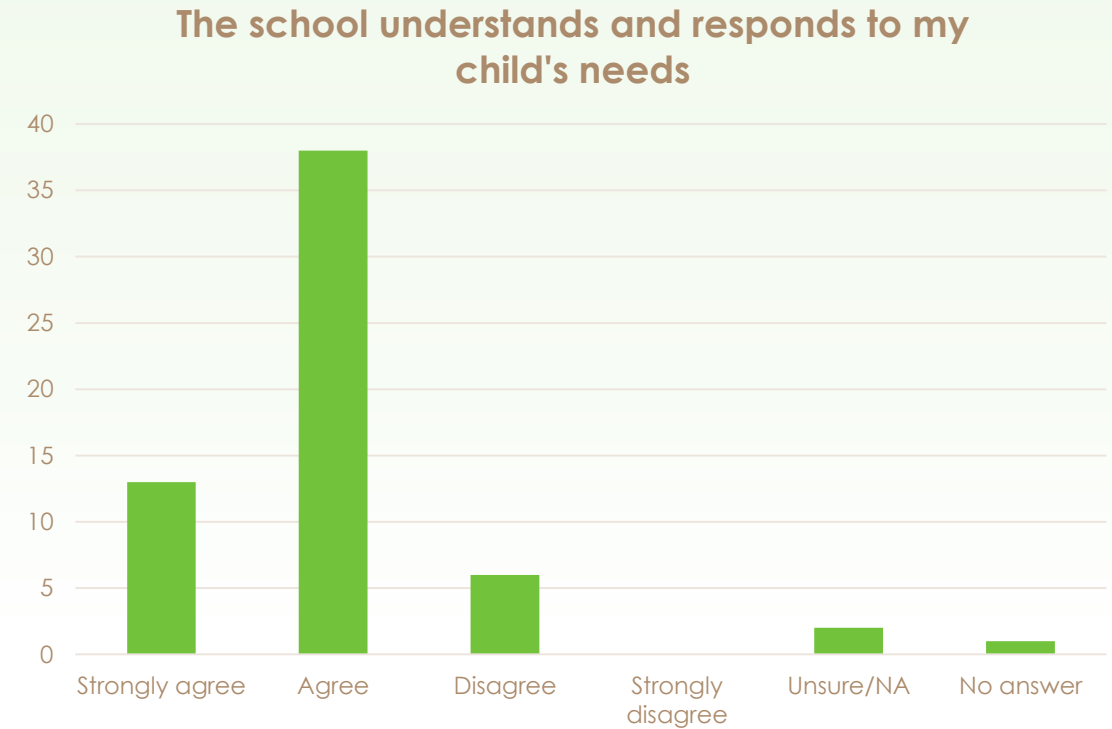

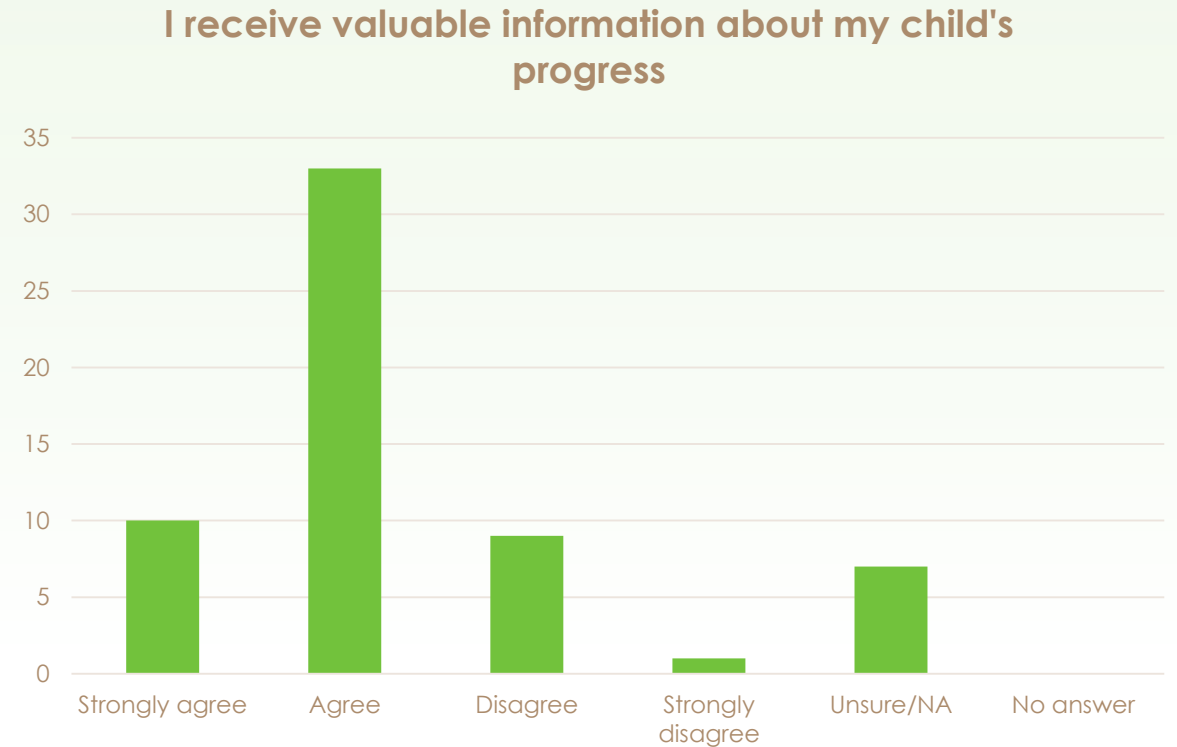

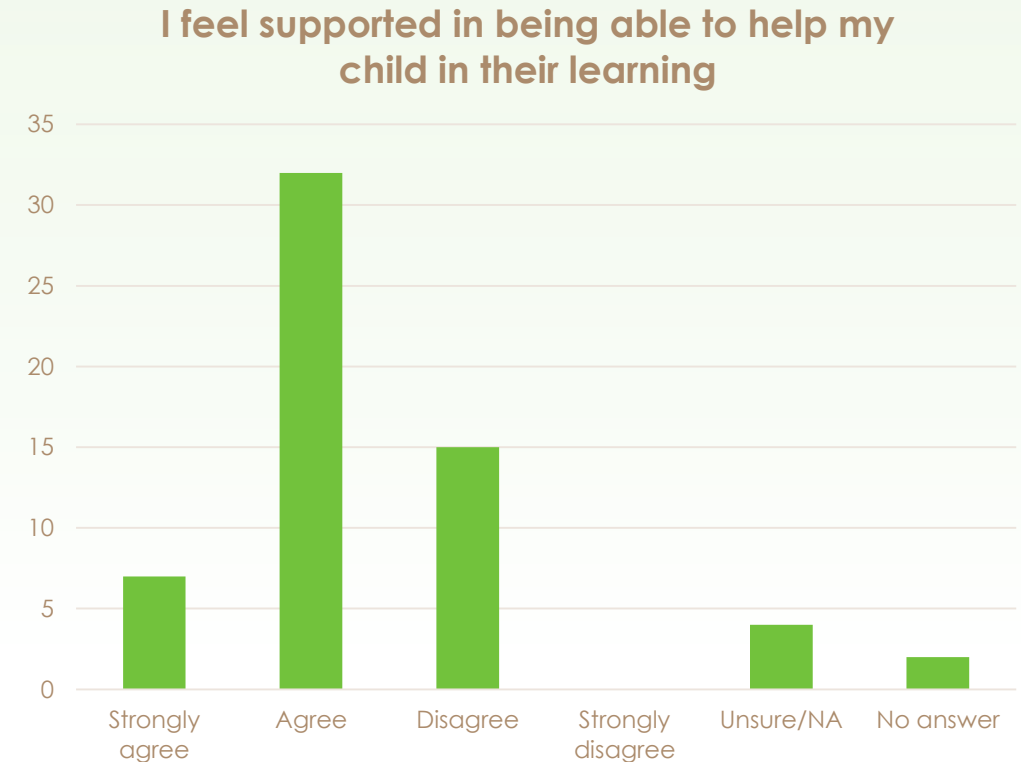

# Teaching and Learning

## STRENGTHS

Teacher responds well to different needs of children  
Benefits of small school  
Dedicated teachers/care/hardworking/supportive/welcoming  
Class Dojo/Tapestry – being involved in school work  
Enjoyed phonics workshop

## CONCERNS

Consistency of staffing  
Pitch of lessons  
Curriculum – not enough real world – prescriptive - more creative teaching needed  
Mathletics  
Brilliant tool – effective use/leave open for practise,/guidance for parents/no feedback on wrong answers/struggle with layout  
Interim Reports - Not very informative

Communication about learning  
Methods for maths/support parents better/improve consistency of approaches/frequency between classes.

Home Learning Tasks  
Too much homework/lack of feedback/need more focussed homework for secondary school/not enough to prepare them for secondary/little or no feedback/self esteem of child who is not chosen for display.

# Teaching and Learning

## ACTIONS

Mathletics – addressed in staff meeting

- lunchtime clubs
- future workshops for parents
- raise profile in school

Teaching & Learning

- staff meeting time to deepen subject knowledge/pedagogical approaches/assessment
- workshops for parents – better understanding/support about learning and expectations
- review of curriculum and opportunities it presents
- enriching experiences e.g. trips/projects
- developing children as learners – learning champions
- class assemblies/informal ‘open’ classrooms

Establish a regular Parent Forum

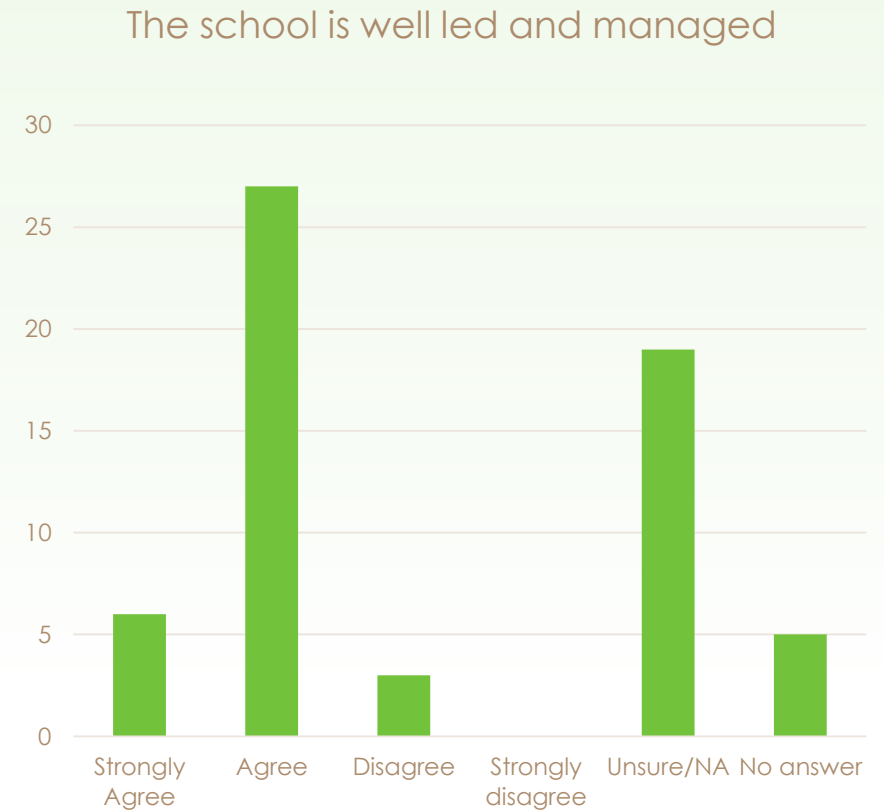

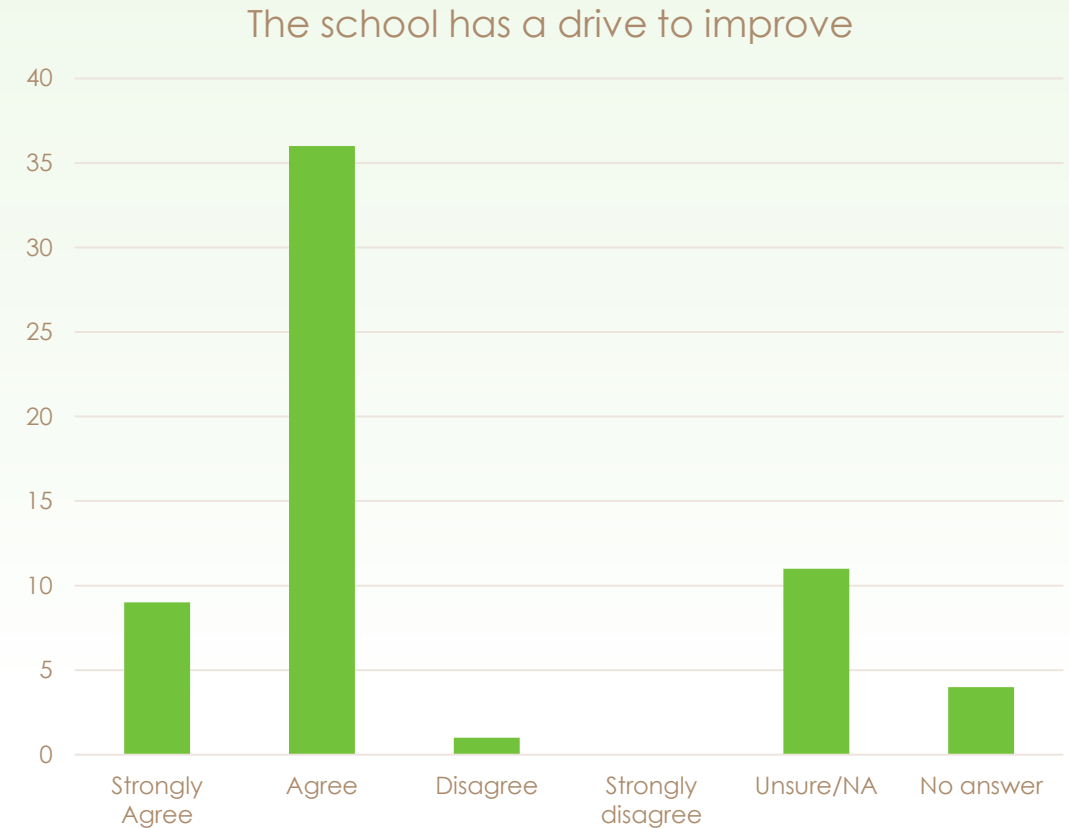

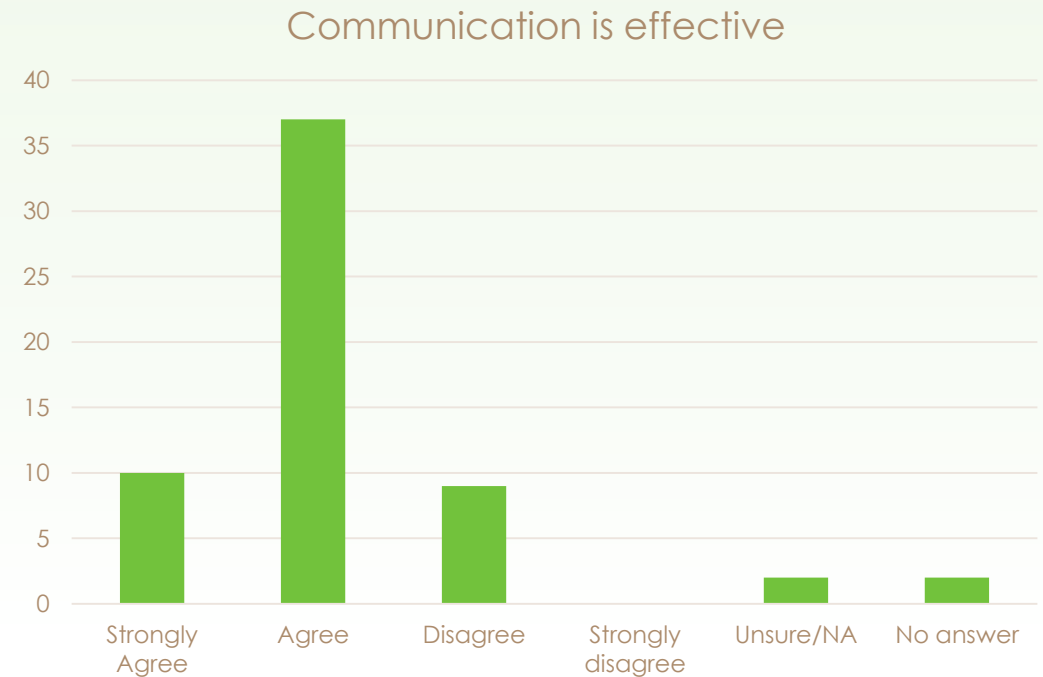

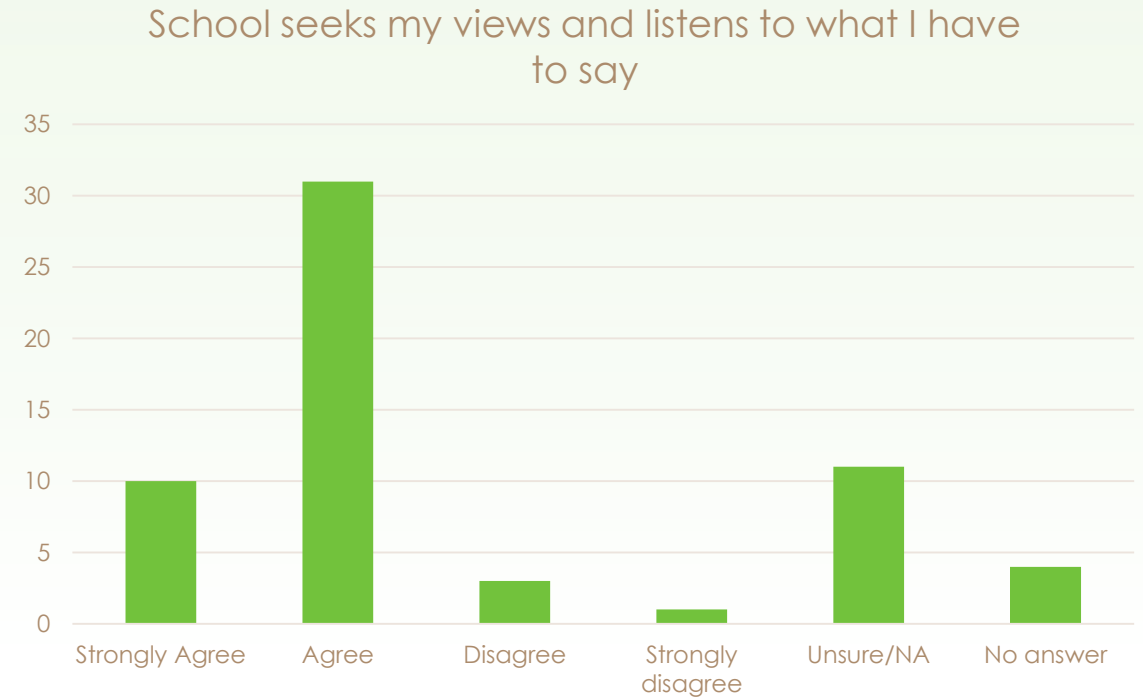

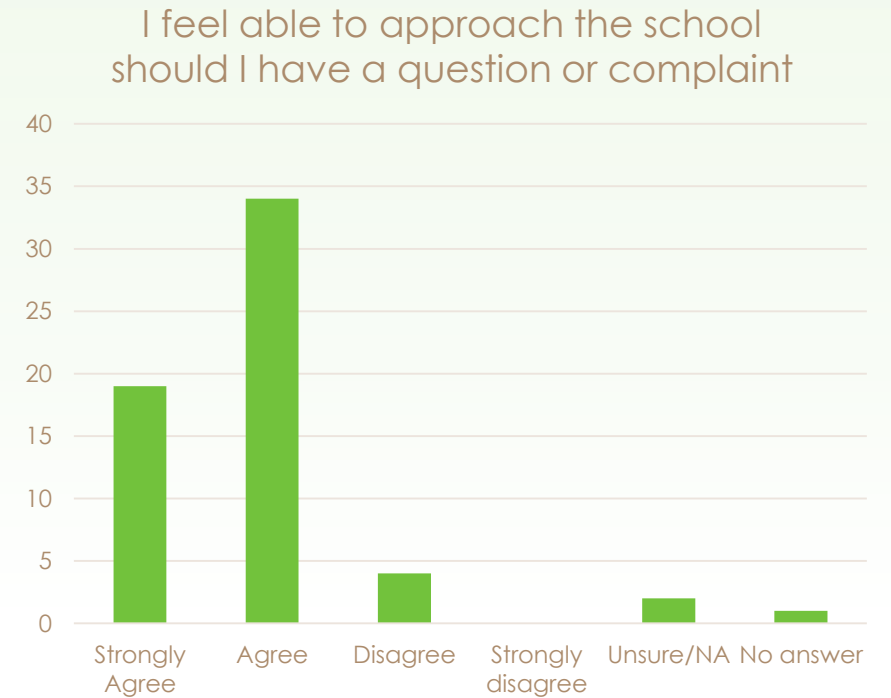

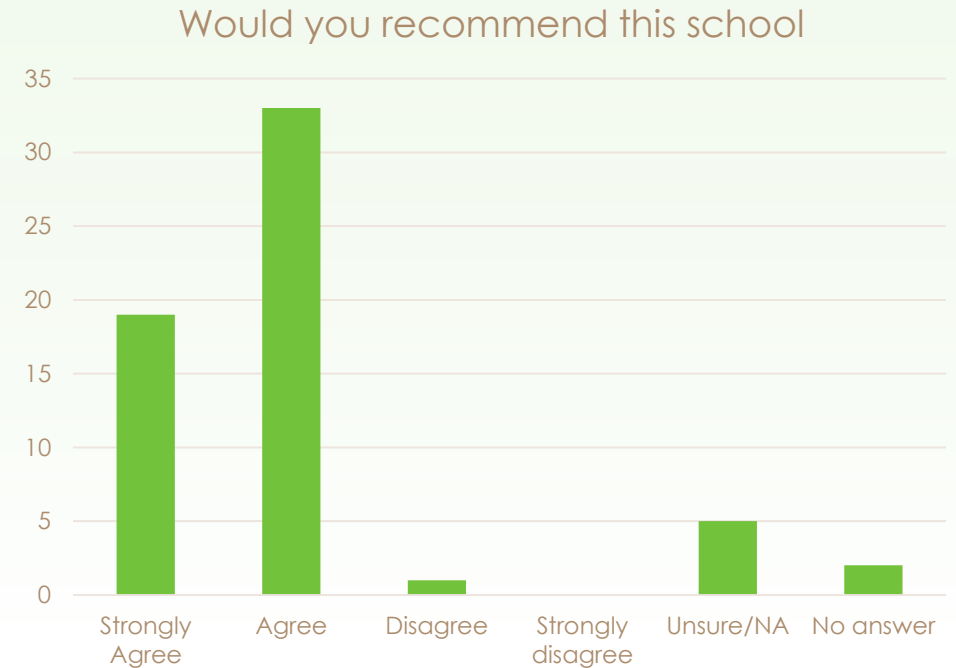
