YEAR 4 – Safe Internet/Anti-Cyberbullying play

It's Dotty's birthday and she's just got a shiny new iPad. But there's a problem. She's not being too safe online. She's posting personal information, chatting to strangers and making rude comments about school friends. When her behaviour results in her being pulled into the computer Dotty finds herself caught 'In the Net'. The clock is ticking and in order to get home she must go on a quest – a quest to find out how to be safer online. Along the way she's helped by a whole host of strange characters.

'In the Net' was developed by the creative team behind our hugely successful CSE awareness-raising play 'Chelsea's Choice', in association with Bridgewater Primary School in Northampton. It is ideal for year 4 students.

IN THE NET

It covers:-

- Safe Internet/Social Media Use
- Keeping personal information safe
- The effects of cyber-bullying on others
- What to do if you are being cyber-bullied
- What to do if you get that 'Oh Oh' feeling online
- What makes a 'healthy relationship'
- What to do if you have questions or concerns

Costs for 2018

- 1 week (up to 10 shows) £4,870+VAT
- 2 week (up to 20 shows) £8,540+VAT (equivalent of £4,270 per week)
- 3 week (up to 30 shows) £12,220+VAT (equivalent of £4,073 per week)
- 4 week (up to 40 shows) £15,890+VAT (equivalent of £3,973 per week)
- Extra weeks (up to 10 shows) charged at £3,520+VAT per week
- Conference/Training/One-off Performances (up to 3 shows in a day) = £1,075+VAT

The play runs at 45 minutes long. When touring we can do 10 shows a week. All we need is a performance space roughly 4m x 4m and somewhere to plug in our sound system. The cast do not use mics so performance venues must be suitable for unamplified voices. The cast aim to arrive one hour before the show start time to set up and take about 30 minutes to pack down.
