Woodchester PTA Bake Off and Vintage Tea Party  
Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2019

On 28th March, we will be holding the Woodchester Bake off Competition. This will be open to both adults and children.

It is free to enter, just bring your bake into school by 11am on 28<sup>th</sup>. It will be judged by an impartial panel.

The winning bakes will be announced at **our vintage tea party in the school hall** from **3.15pm on 28<sup>th</sup> March**. We will be selling the cakes and bakes at the tea party which will be open to all. There will be a raffle which will include the winning bakes.

The rules are as follows:

- To enter, bring in your bake to the school by 11am on 28<sup>th</sup> (together with a completed form below)
- Any bake can be entered, cakes, pasties, pies, bread, as long as it is home-made obviously!
- There are 4 categories: (i) **KS1** (Reception to Yr 2), (ii) **KS2** (Yr 3 – Yr 6) (iii) **Adults** (iv) **Joint Effort Bake** (adult and child)
- Obviously for the children’s bakes some support can be given by adults, particularly for KS1, but we would like the children to choose their own bake and do most of the work
- If you enter the bake, unfortunately you can’t have it back as we will be selling all the bakes to raise funds for the PTA
- The judges’ decision is final
- We are selling cakes to the public so please supervise /ensure appropriate hygiene regime is followed, thank you.
